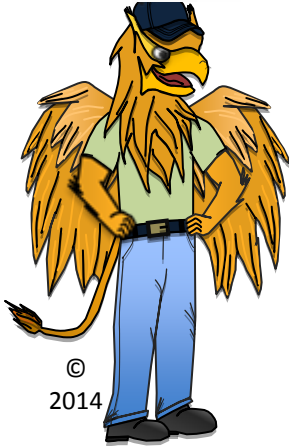

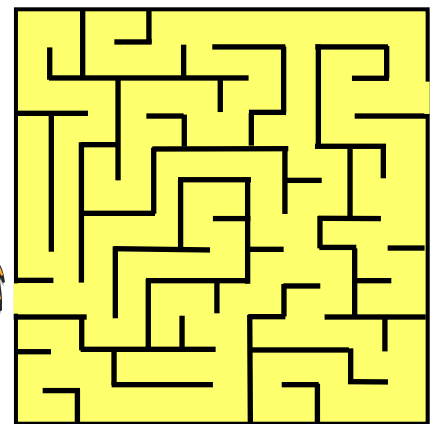
Cyber Bullying
